Property Taxes are due, in full, by September 15th of the same year and the County has a monthly Tax Pre-Authorized Debit (PAD) program.

To avoid being charged under the County Fire Bylaw, with the potential to be invoiced for the cost of the fire department call-out, please follow

• Obtain a County Fire Permit (March 1 to October 31) for ALL areas • Determine if you live within the Forest Protection Area and obtain a burning permit from the Province of Alberta • Determine if it is safe to burn. Full or partial fire bans may be implemented by Mountain View County, Province of Alberta or surrounding municipalities.

Your insurance may not cover a claim for an accident if you do not have a building permit in place. Building permits are important to ensure that your construction meets provincial


