
Dear Mr. Bagnall:

We have for acknowledgement your letter and enclosures dated January, 17th concerning a new crest for the County of Mountain View No. 17.

Having discussed this matter with the College of Arms, we have been advised by Mr. Portcullis of the College of Arms that there are certain formalities which should be completed prior to the issuing of either crests or arms for a County. May we suggest therefore that you communicate with Mr. Portcullis at the College of Arms, LONDON, E.C.4, providing him with sketches of the proposed crest. From these sketches Mr. Portcullis will arrange to have suitable crests or arms designed for the County. Mr. Portcullis will also advise you concerning letter of patent which is the usual thing in arranging crests and coats of arms in any part of the British Commonwealth.

We are returning herewith the three sketches of the proposed crests, forwarded under cover with your letter dated January 17th.

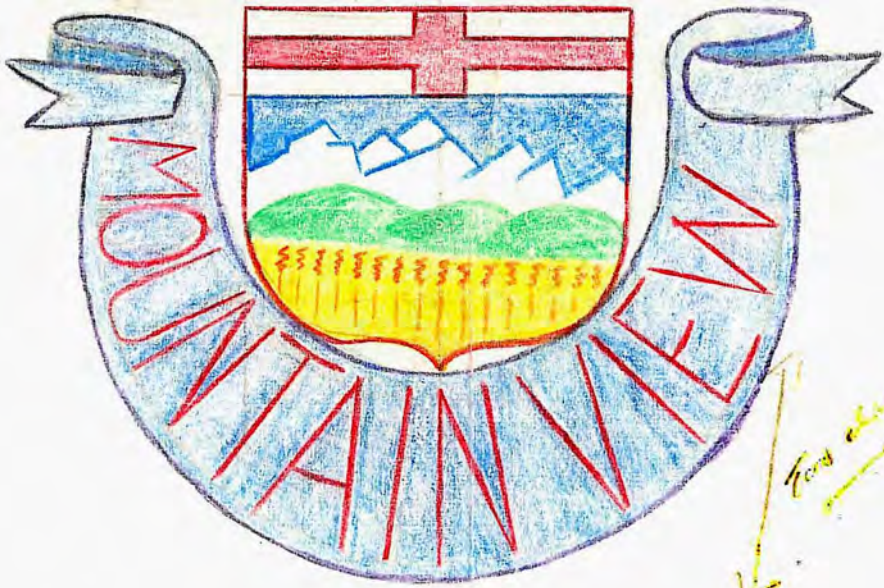

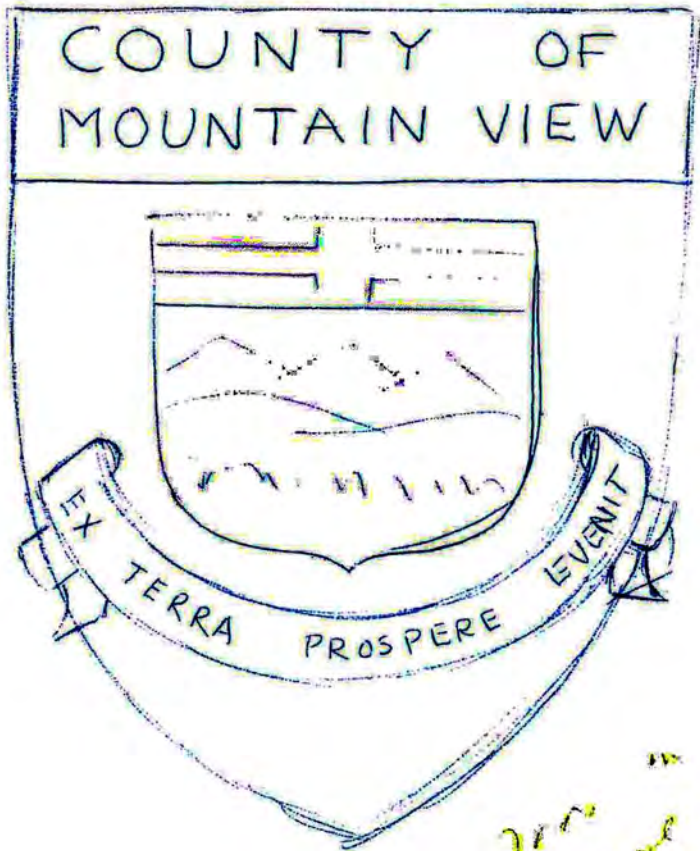
