Mountain View County Bursary – Olds College

Policy Statement: Mountain View County recognizes the benefits of education for youth, specifically, in the areas of technology, innovation and good farm management practices to ensure the continuance of a strong agricultural base in the future; therefore, the County supports the provision of a bursary to a local rural student attending Olds College.

Purpose: To encourage and support agricultural based education and continued learning, for Mountain View County residents, enhancing the ability of youth to make meaningful agriculture contributions to their communities.

Principles:

1. This funding is directed to County residents entering or attending Olds College to take post-secondary level courses of one year or greater that will result in a Certificate or Diploma.

Procedure Title: Olds College Bursary
Procedure No.: 8011-01

Mountain View County Bursary – Olds College

1. General

- 1.1 Applicants must be residents of Mountain View County (ratepayer or dependent of a ratepayer).
- 1.2 Applicants must be entering or attending Olds College in any field, and limited to post-secondary level courses of one or two years or more, leading to a recognized degree, diploma or certificate in that field.
- 1.3 Applicants must provide a budget and demonstrate financial need.
- 1.4 The amount of the bursary shall be \$1,000 per annum, to one (1) award recipient.

2. Guidelines

- 2.1 Olds College will advertise the bursary in their “Scholarship, Bursaries & Prizes” information on the Olds College website.
- 2.2 The Olds College Awards Selection Committee will review applications and select the recipient based on the County’s requirements. The Olds College will contact the County to ensure that the student is a Mountain View County youth.
- 2.3 The award will be presented at a regular County Council meeting.

- 3.1 Financial Need
- 3.2 Academic Excellence
