

BY-LAW #59/00

**BEING A BY-LAW OF MOUNTAIN VIEW COUNTY
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH THE
POSITION OF MUNICIPAL ASSESSOR FOR MOUNTAIN VIEW COUNTY**

WHEREAS Section 210 of the Municipal Government Act provides that a municipality may create a designated officer position to carry out certain duties and responsibilities under the Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS Council now wishes to create a designated officer position to carry out the powers, duties and functions of assessor under the Municipal Government Act as municipal assessor;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Mountain View County, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

ENACTMENT

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Municipal Assessor By-law".

DEFINITIONS

2. Words importing the masculine gender only, include the feminine gender whenever the context so requires and vice versa.
3. Works importing the singular shall include the plural or vice versa whenever the context so requires.


OPERATIVE CLAUSES


4. The position of municipal assessor is hereby created as a designated officer position for Mountain View County.
5. The powers and duties of the municipal assessor shall be:
 - (a) to carry out all obligations imposed upon the municipal assessor pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, c.M-26.1 S.A., 1994 and regulations thereunder;
 - (b) to carry out all duties delegated to the municipal assessor by by-law or resolution of Council or by any other statute, regulation, or order of the Province of Alberta, either prior to or subsequent to the passage of this by-law.
 - (c) to delegate the performance of any duties, powers or obligations of the municipal assessor to such person or corporation as the municipal assessor finds appropriate.
6. The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to appoint a qualified individual as municipal assessor. If no individual is appointed to the position of municipal assessor, the Chief Administrative Officer shall delegate the performance of any duties, powers or obligations of an assessor under the Municipal Government Act to a person who meets the qualifications required pursuant to the Act and regulations.

TRANSITION

7. This by-law comes into effect on the date of final passing.


