
**Re: MGB File: 17/IMD-004 Town of Sundre v Mountain View County re: Bylaw LU 43/17**

Further to the letter provided by the County dated November 22, 2017, regarding MGB File 17/IMD-004, the Town wishes to confirm its written consent to proceed to preliminary hearing on December 6, 2017.

The Town wishes to confirm that a meeting was held between the Administrations of the Town and County on November 10, 2017, in an attempt to reach agreement on a collaborative approach to resolving this matter through further discussions, and to postpone the preliminary hearing to a later date. However, the Town is not prepared to withdraw its appeal under section 690, until the issues raised in our previous correspondence to the County are satisfactorily addressed.

We therefore request that the MGB proceed to preliminary hearing on the basis of the appeal filed by the Town.
