Didsbury Fire Services Information Update

DIDSBURY – On Friday, July 20, 2018, as part of an Inter-municipal Collaboration Committee (ICC), Town of Didsbury and Mountain View County representatives met to discuss the Didsbury Fire Department situation. As a result of this meeting, the Town of Didsbury and Mountain View County Councils and Administration are providing the following update regarding the Didsbury Fire Department.

Council and Administration of both the Town of Didsbury and Mountain View County continue to assure the public that our local Fire Department is able to handle emergency situations that arise in our area. Mutual Aid agreements have been in effect with neighboring municipalities for many years that would provide for additional resources and personnel in the event that a situation is larger than the Didsbury department can handle.

In addition, the Town of Didsbury Council and Administration assures area residents that they are working diligently to rectify internal issues within the department and to implement an action plan that will allow for a positive move-forward strategy. As part of this move-forward, Didsbury Town Council will be discussing a Fire Department Safety Audit during their July 24, 2018 Regular Council Meeting.

Mountain View County Council and Administration continue to support the Town of Didsbury and the volunteer members of the Fire Department as they work towards a mutual resolution to the current situation.
