Steering Committee Formed (Typically all MVC Council)

Process starts

First Reading of the Bylaw is given and a date for the Public Hearing is set.

Public Hearings are advertised for 2 weeks.

Public Hearing

Provides the opportunity for any public member to address Council directly

Optional Path * Following the public hearing Council may determine additional public engagement is required

Second reading and Third reading.

Council may make amendments during deliberation of second, and third reading

Adoption of Land Use Bylaw
