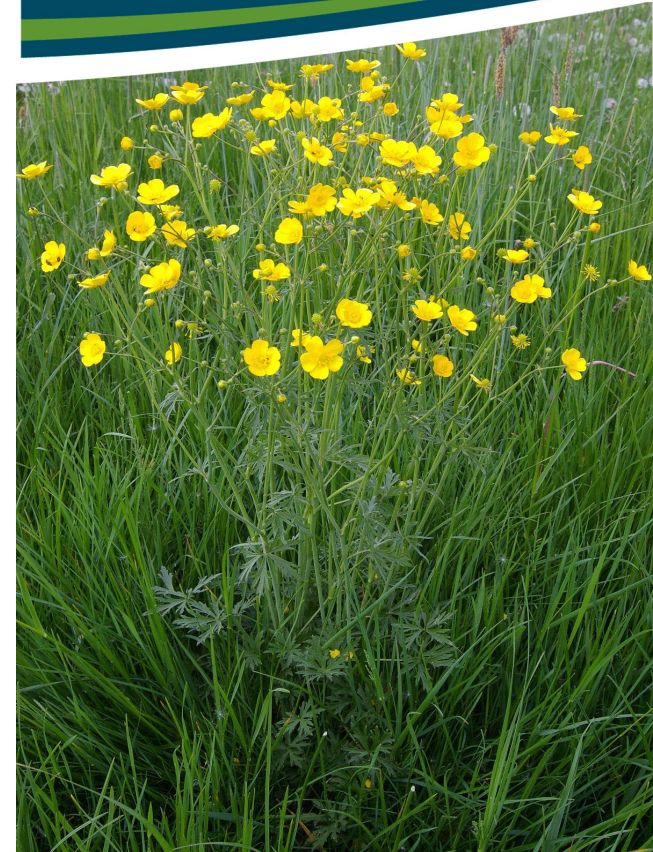

Mountain View County Agricultural Service Board offers a number of different incentives and services to assist landowners in controlling prohibited noxious and noxious weeds.



Details on the 20% Rebate Program

Who Qualifies for the Incentive

Mountain View County residents controlling prohibited noxious and noxious weeds on range and pasture lands with approved herbicides by label directions or recognized Biological Control methods.

How do Eligible Land Owners Access the Incentive

Contact Mountain View County agricultural staff and make them aware of the lands intended for herbicide weed control. Upon completion of the application process, the appropriate receipts for the approved herbicides are to be forwarded to Mountain View County agricultural staff. The receipt is to include the number of units of herbicide purchased, a legal land location of where the herbicide has been applied, the target weeds sprayed and the date of when applications occurred.



How are Incentive Applications Approved

Agricultural staff has the discretion to approve or deny incentive applications to the limits of the approved budget set by the Mountain View County Agricultural Service Board. Agricultural staff may follow up and inspect the designated lands. Upon approval a payment of 20% for the herbicide cost will be reimbursed.



Available FREE OF CHARGE:

The Agricultural Service Board has an equipment rental program to assist landowners and lease holders in the County to control weeds

- 1 400 gallon pull behind sprayer with boomless nozzles, capable of spraying a 36 foot span (tractor required)
- 2 125 gallon slide in truck mounted sprayer with hand wand and boomless nozzles, capable of spraying a 30 foot span
- 3 100 liter quad sprayer
- 4 Backpack and handheld sprayers
