

December 1, 2021

Council approved the 2022 Budget, which included the review of the South McDougal Flats Area Structure Plan.



February 9, 2022

Council approved the Terms of Reference for the South McDougal Flats Area Structure Plan Review.



March 23, 2022

Council appointed public members and Councillors as Steering Committee Members for the South McDougal Flats Area Structure Plan Review



May 10, 2022 to Now

Total 10 meetings. Discussion topics include: zoning changes, subdivision and developments since 2010; Provincial studies, gravel pits and industrial development.










Land Use Concept: Agriculture & Low Density




Lands identified as **Agricultural & Low Density** will continue to support agricultural activities and are proposed to allow for a total of four (4) titles per quarter section.

Land Use Concept: Residential



Lands identified as **Residential** applies to quarter sections with existing subdivisions or quarter sections with only one or two subdivided lots. The survey provides examples with the potential number of parcels, size of the parcels and the number of residents.


Land Use Concept: Recreation




Lands identified as **Recreation** are intended to provide activities such as walking trails and developments such as campgrounds.
