Excerpt from the Municipal Government Act, Section 678(1):

The decision of a subdivision authority on an application for subdivision may be appealed

- (a) by the applicant for the approval,
- (b) by a Government department if the application is required by the subdivision and development regulations to be referred to that department,
- (c) by the council of the municipality in which the land to be subdivided is located if the council, a designated officer of the municipality or the municipal planning commission of the municipality is not the subdivision authority, or
- (d) by a school authority with respect to
 - i. the allocation of municipal reserve and school reserve or money in place of the reserve,
 - ii. the location of school reserve allocated to it, or
 - iii. the amount of school reserve or money in place of the reserve.

If you are authorized and wish to appeal, please provide your written appeal within 14 days of receipt of the written decision to: Subdivision and Development Appeal Board - Postal Bag 100, Didsbury, AB TOM OW0.
An appeal fee of \$425.00 must accompany the appeal.
