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APPROACH CONSTRUCTION CHECKLIST

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Developers: Please be aware that all approaches must be constructed as per Mountain View County standards as stated in Policy 4005. https://www.mountainviewcounty.com/p/policies

- New and/or existing approaches to the <u>new parcel</u> and the <u>balance</u> to be upgraded to current MVC standards or removed as required by conditions of approval.
 - □ Location
 - □ Width
 - □ Slopes
 - □ Surfacing Standards (Surface with 75mm (3") depth of 20mm (¾") crushed gravel, recycled asphalt, or pavement structure as specified by Mountain View County Operational Services Department.)
 - □ Approach grade
 - □ Shoulder Radius
 - □ Maximum approach grade
 - □ If the applicant is not the landowner, written consent from the landowner must be included.
- Site lines to meet MVC standards May need to clear existing tress, hedges, etc.
- Drainage Requirements
 Existing Approach may need re-grading as required by condition of approval
- Culvert requirement to meet MVC Standards Culverts should be located at the toe of backslope whenever possible Rip Rap installed flush with slope
- Disturbed or newly constructed side slope, backslope and ditch bottom to be topsoiled and seeded to current County specifications. Seed certification to be approved by MVC Operational Services
- Utility line located required prior to construction (1st call)
- Surfaces on all approaches must be consistent with the adjoining road
- Applicant has consulted with the landowner (if required) If the applicant for the approach is not the landowner, consultation with the affected landowner by the applicant is recommended prior to construction.

Notes:

All requirements are at the sole expense of the developer.
